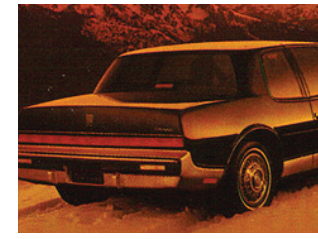
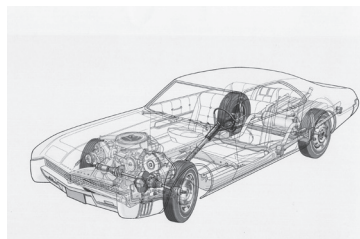

Here are a few of the many benefits to joining:

What is required to become a member of the TOA?

Ownership of a Toronado is NOT required for membership in the TOA. (After all, if you like the Toronado, membership in the club is the best way to find the perfect vehicle!) We are an independent club, not affiliated with any other car club. Many of our members belong to the Oldsmobile Club of America. We encourage such dual membership. Membership in another club is NOT a requirement to belong to the Toronado Owners Association

What does it cost to belong?

We believe that the benefits of membership are worth far more than the cost of dues. Membership in the TOA is on an annual basis. New members receive the current magazine issue and the next five issues each year.
